- CANCELLATION POLICY -

A 48 hour notice is required for cancellation of a reservation to receive a refund. Within 48 hours of scheduled tour time, there is no refund and a change/move fee of 25% applies. All trips depart rain or shine, on time, as scheduled. In the event that a tour is canceled by Denali ATV, a full refund will be provided.

- DRIVER RESTRICTIONS -

Minimum age for Single ATV is 18 (16 with parental approval). Minimum age for Side by Side ATV Driver is 21 (18 with parental approval). Driver & passengers of Side by Side ATVs can share driving. Alaska State Law requires that all ATV drivers must be at least 16 years old. For safety reasons, all drivers must understand English & have a valid driver's license. Not recommended for people with back or neck problems & women who are pregnant. All riders must sign a Participation Agreement prior to the tour.
